In signing the Covenant Code of Honour, I fully recognize that Meridian Pre-university was founded on the authority of God's word and is committed to being a Christian Pre-university. It is therefore my personal commitment to be a person of integrity in my attitude and respect for Meridian Pre-university.

I COVENANT to apply myself wholehearted to my academic studies and to use my mind for the glory of God.

I COVENANT to grow in my Spirit in developing my own relationship with God through prayer and the reading of the word.

I COVENANT to exercise my body regularly to be in good health.

I COVENANT to cultivate good social relationship with others and to seek to love others as myself. I will not lie, I will not steal, I will not cheat, I will not be involved in gossip, I will not fight, I will not curse and I will dress decently.

I COVENANT to keep myself under subjection from all immoral and illegal acts and habits, whether on or off school, I will refrain from illicit sexual acts; I will not drink alcoholic beverages of any kind; I will not use tobacco; I will not engage in any behavior that is contrary to the rules and regulations listed in the students Handbook.

I COVENANT to respect the leadership of the Pre-University, faculty and staff and my fellow students.

I COVENANT to be diligent and punctual in attending classes, programs and functions as required.

I COVENANT to fulfill all financial obligations that I enter into while enrolled at Meridian Pre-university.

I COVENANT to abide by the rules and regulations, which may from time to time be adopted by the Pre-University Administration. I understand Meridian Pre-university is a private Pre-University and I therefore have no vested right in the governing of this Pre-University. I accept my attendance at Meridian Pre-university as a privilege and not a right and that the Pre-University reserves the right to require the withdrawal of a student upon the request of the Disciplinary Committee under the direction of the Vice Chancellor.

DRESS CODE

In signing the Dress Code, I fully recognize MPU’s regulations regarding the selection of presentable, durable work clothes for physical work, modest casual attire for recreational purposes and more dignified clothing for classes and group worship.

Role Distinction:

The following regulations shall apply at all times to all dresses worn on campus. Since students are being trained to be high-class business executives, managers and leaders of reputable institutions or organizations, it is appropriate for them to wear such outfits that benefit such offices.

Health: Choosing clothing which promotes good blood circulation, avoiding tight, restrictive fashions and styles which produce unnatural posturing.

WOMEN

1. Women are to wear clothes and hairstyles, which emphasize the unique and sacred identities of women.

- a. Skirts must be long enough to cover knees
- b. Transparent, sheer or tight fitting blouses and sweaters or skirts are not permitted
- c. Short blouses and dresses with low necklines are not permitted.
- d. Sort, tight-fitting slacks and similar clothing are not considered appropriate attire for lectures. However, properly fitting slacks may be worn for outdoor recreational programs

2. Women are to wear hairstyles, which emphasize the unique and sacred identities of women at all times.

MEN

- 1. Men’s dress for school or general campus wear shall consist of trousers and collared shirts with tie or decent African wear.
- 2. ‘T’-shirts are not considered appropriate attire for lectures
